During the Hanukkah season, we can once again light up the world. The Green Team at CBST has joined the Natural Resources Defense Council's #LEDChallenge. One LED lightbulb can last for 15 to 25 years and is incredibly cheap: a typical incandescent costs \$5.74 a year to own and operate, compared to only \$1.34 for an LED. Learn more about the benefits of switching!

If every household in America switched out just one incandescent bulb for one LED, over 10 years, we'd prevent 2 million metric tons of carbon pollution from entering our atmosphere—equal to taking more than 425,000 cars off the road for a year—and cut down on asthma attacks, heart attacks, lung cancers, and other diseases caused by power-plant pollution.

Become a part of the movement: switch at least one light bulb in your home to an LED. They're cheaper than ever and widely available at stores and online.
