Cantor Benjie Ellen Schiller (1958-) is Professor of Cantorial Arts at the Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion, Debbie Friedman School of Sacred Music, in New York. Her work involves training cantorial students to bridge the gap between performance and spiritual leadership. She received her bachelor's degree in composition from Boston University and was ordained as a cantor at Hebrew Union College. A nationally-known composer, her most recent publication is "Azamra," a collection of beautiful liturgical pieces. Since 1989 Cantor Schiller has served as the cantor at Bet Am Shalom Synagogue of White Plains, New York, alongside her husband, Rabbi Lester Bronstein.
