Adult B* Mitzvah Program

The CBST Adult B*Mitzvah program is a 2-year (4 semester) Jewish learning program which culminates in a handful of group B*Mitzvah Shabbat services in the spring and fall of the 2nd year. Our classes are taught by CBST clergy and educators and cover a range of topics, from liturgy and theology to Hebrew language and Torah cantillation.

To date, over 80 CBST members have participated in our program and have been called to the Torah as adult B*Mitzvah. Graduates of our Adult B*Mitzvah program have gone on to become regular Torah readers at our Shabbat morning minyanim and High Holy Day services too!

- CBST membership in good standing

- Regular attendance at CBST Shabbat evening and Shabbat morning services
- All participants in the CBST Adult B* Mitzvah program must be Jewish.

Schedule and Costs

- Cost for the 2-year program begins at \$1800 with additional cost for *Kiddish lunch sponsorship.
- There are 4 semesters over the 2-years, they begin in the fall.
- Schedule and description of classes of courses will be finalized in the summer.
- CBST celebrates our Adult B* Mitzvah in small groups of 2-4 students on a Shabbat Morning, of our Liberal Minyan, in the spring of the 2nd year.

* B*Mitzvah participants are responsible for sponsoring a celebratory community Kiddush <u>as a group</u> on the morning of their B*Mitzvah service. Cost for this varies depending on food, catering, size, and staff.
