

Limmud B'Shabbat is CBST's Jewish education program for children connecting students to each other, their class cohort, and their Jewish identity. Engaging in-person sessions include prayer, study, Hebrew instruction, exploration of Jewish texts and core values, brought to life through art, drama, music, Jewish culture, and LGBTQ+ values. The program is overseen by Rabbi Yael Werber and taught by exceptional faculty and professional songleaders. We offer need-based scholarships and payment plans to keep our Jewish learning accessible.

Mobile phones and other electronic devices must be silenced during services. Photography, videography, and audio recording of services are not permitted; our services are livestreamed and archived.

Accessibility: We have designated areas for open captioning and wheelchair accessibility.

Masonic Hall: accessible single stall restrooms are on the Second Floor.

Jacob Javits Convention Center: accessible restrooms are in the River Pavilion.

CBST on 30th Street: restrooms are accessible and available on every floor.


