COMPOSER FEATURE

Cantor **Benjie Ellen Schiller** (Born 1958) is a nationally known composer whose works include "Life-Song Cycle," a series of pieces for Jewish life passage ceremonies; "Halleluhu," a multi-rhythmic setting of Psalm 150; and various commissioned works for synagogues, choirs, and interfaith liturgical groups. Cantor Schiller's arrangements and compositions are featured on the two recordings made by the Beged Kefet philanthropic Jewish music ensemble. She has served as Cantor of Bet Am Shalom Synagogue in White Plains. Cantor Schiller recently retired from her decades long position as a Professor of Cantorial Arts at Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion. She received her bachelor's degree in composition from Boston University.
