Rabbi Hanna Tiferet Siegel, a trailblazer in Jewish Renewal, was the first woman to receive the titles Eshet Hazon (Woman of Vision) and Miyaledet Neshama (Midwife of the Soul) in 1982. She was ordained as a Rabbinic Pastor in 1992 and as a Rabbi in 2003 by Reb Zalman Schachter-Shalomi. Hanna earned a Masters of Jewish Studies from Boston Hebrew College and studied as a Melton Senior Educator at Hebrew University. A member of the ALEPH Hashpa'ah Faculty, she is also a Soul Memory Facilitator and has recorded eight albums of original liturgical music.

May Their Memories Be a Revolution

Five hundred days of captivity preceded the heart-wrenching return this week of the bodies of hostages Oded Lifshitz, Ariel Bibas, and Kfir Bibas yesterday. On Sunday, CBST joins the Hostages and Missing Families Forum as a co-sponsor of a rally marking over 500 Days of captivity, advocating for all the hostages and for all parties to move the deal to its end and make sure they all come home. The rally is at 12:00 noon at Naumburg Bandshell in Central Park.

Avinu Shebashamayim, our loving Guardian in Heaven, our Rock and Redeemer, bless and protect the land of Israel and all who dwell within it.
