Rabbi Hanna Tiferet Siegel was the first woman to receive the title of *Eshet Hazon*/Woman of Vision, and *Miyaledet Neshama*/Midwife of the Soul at a ceremony designed for her on Shavu'ot in 1982. She received ordination as a Rabbinic Pastor in 1992 from Reb Zalman Schachter-Shalomi and as a Rabbi in 2003 from Reb Zalman and many of her rabbinic colleagues in Jewish Renewal. She also earned a Masters of Jewish Studies Degree at Boston Hebrew College in 2003. Hanna studied at the Hebrew University in Jerusalem as a Melton Senior Educator in 1996-97. She is currently a member of the ALEPH (Alliance for Jewish Renewal) Hashpa'ah Faculty.
