## COMPOSER FEATURE

**Aaron Copland (1900–1990)** was born in Brooklyn, New York, the son of Russian Jewish immigrants. Though he never identified strongly as a religious composer, his music is inseparable from the American experience, painting its open prairies, its idealism, and immigrant longing for belonging into music. After studying with Nadia Boulanger in Paris, Copland returned to America determined to forge a distinctly national sound, drawing on jazz, folk song, and hymn. Works like Appalachian Spring, Fanfare for the Common Man, and Lincoln Portrait became cultural touchstones. A gay man who navigated the McCarthy era with resilience, Copland's outsider perspective animated his art.
